



Red Card Procedure

Note this procedure covers all Florida Premiership leagues (NPL, FPL, DEV, RED)

Red card is issued at the game

Action: Referee MUST indicate on the game report (as this is signed by both coaches) AND referee must complete the supplemental which can be found here <https://floridapremiership.org/referee-resources/>

Action: Club will report this red card to the league by emailing this admin w/ the game report, supplemental (if rosters were provided at the game - then they should be sent too).

- The league has a standard infraction/sanction posted on line for ALL to see: <https://floridapremiership.org/red-card-report-2/>

Action: League will read the report and based on the standard we have in place (see bullet above) email the club to acknowledge receipt of paperwork - and confirm the sanction. IF the cards were S or VC those get sent to our committee for review and further consideration. A copy is also sent onto US Club for tracking purposes. The league will post on red card report online by the following Friday.

Action: Player will serve suspension - from a league perspective this does not need to be in person (some clubs make the players sit the bench, that's on the club). When a player is serving it MUST be noted on the game card that player name, and pass number was serving a suspension during that game. The team can still have 18 on the game day roster with the player serving the suspension.

Action: Club will email game reports as proof of suspension back to admin for tracking purposes and so that the red card report can be updated.

Note that the club is responsible for informing your teams of the suspension.
